## **Expression of Interest - Directorial Team for & Juliet**

Holiday Actors is excited to present & *Juliet* in 2026, with performances running from **3rd to the 10th of January**. We are now seeking expressions of interest from individuals or teams interested in forming the directorial team for this production.

#### **Roles Available**

We are looking for a talented team, including:

- Director
- Musical Director
- Choreographer
- Vocal Director

Applicants may apply either **solo** or as part of a **team**. A full team is not required to submit an application. You may also apply if you're interested in being an **assistant** to any of these positions.

### **How to Apply**

Interested parties should submit a short document outlining:

- Their relevant experience
- Their vision and ideas for the production
- Any other key information they believe is important

Please keep applications *concise*, as we may need to review several submissions. If you are applying as part of a team, include all your team's information in one document - **maximum 4 pages**. At this stage we only need your details and a brief outline of your vision. You will have the chance to expand on this at the interview, if you are successful.

#### **Selection Process**

Teams or individuals under consideration will be invited for an interview with the Holiday Actors selection committee to present their ideas for the production.











## **Important Considerations**

There are contractual requirements for & *Juliet* that must be adhered to, which may impact your creative plans:

- The time period must remain in the Shakespearean era. The setting cannot be altered to different time periods or locations.
- The band or orchestra cannot be onstage. They must be positioned either in the pit or in front of the stage.
- Character genders must remain as written in the script. & Juliet includes a diverse range of characters, including a non-binary character, and these identities must remain unchanged. However, casting performers in roles outside their gender identity (e.g., casting a male-identifying performer in a female role) is permitted, as long as the character's gender and pronouns remain as stated in the script.
- You cannot replicate or copy anything from the professional productions of & Juliet you may have seen. This includes costume design, choreography, set pieces, etc. You'll need to get creative!

#### **Submission Details**

Interviews for potential directorial individuals and teams will be at **7pm on Monday April 28th**.
